

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSSION, SUGGESTION AND LIMITATIONS

A. Conclusion

After conducting research and various scientific work procedures in the preparation of this dissertation, the following is the conclusion obtained:

1. The result of the research found that the most type which has used in English language teaching in Indonesia according to the journals and articles published from 2012 to 2022 is the electronic Gamification with percentage 77% (Quizizz app 38,5%, Kahoot app 15,4%, Duolingo app 15,4% and Bamboozles app 7,7%). Although there are benefits of electronic Gamification which has described by the articles and journals published, it also have limitation on the internet network, teacher technical on using Gamification, purchase for upgrading the application and the limitation of device provided by school.
2. The use of Gamification has big impact to engage and enhance students' motivation in English language teaching according to journals and articles published in Indonesia from 2012 to 2022.

B. Suggestion

For future researchers, it is hope that there will be further research on the analysis of the use of Gamification in English teaching in Indonesia. This is necessary in order to update the analysis data because every year there is an increase and change in research results. So that it is hoped that further research can provide better information about the use of Gamification in English language teaching through a qualitative meta-analysis. Although the researcher expects the perfection of this thesis, there are still many shortcomings due to lack of knowledge about research. Thus criticism and suggestion are very much expected readers as evaluation material.

C. **Limitations**

There are many limitations of this research, because it only focuses on the type of Gamification and the result of the research (the effect of Gamification for enhancing students' motivation). So it is hope that future researchers will conduct research that does not only focus on research result but can also focus on research samples, research methods, research objective, implications or limitation of the study.
