## CHAPTER V CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

## A. Conclusion

Based on the data, the research that has been done by the researcher through analysis of the textbooks "Work in Progress" published by Kemdikbud, the researcher concludes several conclusions in this study as follows:

- 1. The aims of this research are to find out the moral values in the "Work in Progress" textbook in the EFL textbook. There are 9 moral values found in this EFL textbook, namely joy of reading, friendly/communicative, creativity, national spirit, hardworking, discipline, curiosity, rewarding achievement, and religiosity. There are some moral values not found in this book, such as honesty, tolerance, independence, democracy, love homeland, love peace, environmental care, social care and responsibility.
- 2. The results of this research are several moral values in the textbook "Work in Progress" published by the Ministry of Education and Culture which are presented through instructional objectives, pictures, and exercise instructions. The moral values contained in textbooks can be used as guidance for students in everyday life. This English book is closely related to oneself in learning moral values for school, social and community life.

## **B.** Suggestion

From the results and discussion in the research above, there are several suggestions that the researcher would like to convey:

- 1. For academic institutions who know and read this research, the researcher advises them to implement the moral values contained in English textbooks in their daily lives.
- 2. For teachers to apply the moral values contained in textbooks with an independent curriculum so that the learning process runs well.

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3. For students who read the results of this research, the researcher suggests applying moral values in your life, school, and society.
