# CHAPTER I INTRODUCTION

## A. Research Background

Online video is one of the Web 2.0 tools that are increasingly being used in current learning models. Youtube is an example of a very popular video-sharing resource that students can use well, effectively, and can use anywhere, to involve students in learning, discussing together, and achieving learning goals. About 2 years ago, the education sector was shocked by the coronavirus which resulted in schools switching to using the online system. Where the teacher teaching system through social media. Youtube, as a medium that is currently widely used by people, can be a medium for children to support learning from home.

Youtube is a Web 2.0 that works in video sharing, commenting, and viewing. Youtube also provides features for commenting on videos, creating appropriate tags with uploaded videos, and can even be used to upload videos. Video creators could add titles and descriptions to videos. Creators can also share the video links on social media as well to inform other viewers to watch videos uploaded on the channel. The affective filter has decreased and the cognitive load has decreased, so YouTube makes students motivated and learning is absorbed more quickly by students. Created in 2005, currently YouTube has more than 70 million videos, 200,000 videos uploaded every day, with an average uploader age of 26 years.

80% of videos are amateur, 15% are professional, and 5% are commercially produced.<sup>3</sup>

Youtube has changed the world of digital creations, hence this redemption can be said to be very broad.<sup>4</sup> Because YouTube currently has a very broad scope, YouTube has also penetrated the world of education. Along with the times, Youtube can now be used as learning media. Many channels on Youtube share educational videos. One of them is the "Kampung Inggris LC – Language Center" Youtube channel. "Kampung Inggris LC – Language Center" youtube channel is an official YouTube account from Kampung Inggris Pare Kediri. Kampung Inggris Pare Kediri is an environment that provides English courses with several programs. Kampung Inggris Pare is also a big non-formal educational environment for English courses. There are around 150 officially registered English courses in Kampung Inggris Pare. Kampung Inggris Pare not only provides teaching through offline courses, but Kampung Inggris Pare also provides online teaching in the form of a YouTube channel. So, we do not need to go to Pare Kediri to be able to learn English. Only by using mobile phones, we can explore the lessons provided by Kampung Inggris Pare.

"Kampung Inggris LC – Language Center" youtube channel which now has 1.74M subscribers is a youtube channel that is very popular with people learning English. The Youtube channel is the most popular among students. In the "Kampung Inggris LC – Language Center" YouTube channel, many videos discuss learning English.

What's interesting about this channel is that the discussion of material is packaged in a fun, and not boring way, besides that it's not just one tutor, there are many different tutors in each video. In addition, there is not only 1 video that we can use to improve our speaking skills, but several videos we can use as a reference to improve our speaking skills.

Several studies have been done by researchers about the use of YouTube as a medium to improve speaking skills with the result that there is a significant effect of using YouTube as a medium to improve speaking skills.<sup>17</sup> On the other hand, different research said that students agree that using YouTube can improve their English speaking skills in speaking class.<sup>18</sup>

Therefore, from the several studies above, in this study, the writer opens up existing research gaps by using youtube
