CHAPTER V CONCLUSION & RECOMMENDATION

A. Conclusion of The Research

Based on the result of research that has been conducted by the researcher about exploring students' motivation for joining English club at an Islamic University State. The researcher concluded three points that will elaborated into paragraphs below.

Students' motivation in learning the English language led to their choice to join English Club, they want to increase their skills and encompass better insight into learning the English language. Besides, the reasons, there existed several motives lied behind their act of joining the English Club. Such as their craving to have more activities after classes, merely needing a partner to have English conversation, their aspiration being a tutor, their desire to supply the deprivation practice in English language learning, their expectation to grow their social relation, and even simply they stimulated by their peers to register.

Since students decided to be a member of the English Club, there were numerous programs and projects held by the functionaries, with the purpose to facilitate and maintain members' learning English language process. Eventually, during participation in the various programs of the English Club, the members acquired countless supporting parts from their surroundings. Including encouragement from the parent and family, the backing up from the peers, the benefit of the program itself, and the experiences of organization skills. Even though, the member also dealt with obstacles that occurred around the environment. An example is an unsupported partner, unobtained occasions for practice, an incapable tutor, and the most highlighted by the member was the unrealized target of the program.

After exploring the students' motivation in joining English Club and finding out the supporting part also the obstacles from the student experience. The result of the explanation clarified the point in which the students agreed that their motivation affected the English Club Program and vice versa. The link between motivation and the English Club program was related correlatively, which is the program of English Club made by the functionaries to facilitate the member, in the same line the program of English Club needs the students to participate and contribute to the activity.

B. Recommendation

This finding had contribution to understand students' motivation for joining English club. As the study progress a point surfaced as suggestion for the future study. This finding showed that there were several factors that influenced students' motivation. It is a recommendation to conduct a specific research about each factor of students' motivation. As such, only a few aspects identified. It will be wide worthwhile find more kind of motivation for joining English club in the different view. This research can be useful as input for the English club for the future functionaries to count the students' motivation in order to make program and distinguish the motive of the students for joining English club, so the functionaries recognize which part the students have passion on it.
