

## CHAPTER III

### RESEARCH METHODOLOGY

#### A. Research Method

This research is the type of descriptive research that uses the qualitative method. The qualitative method is a type of research in which data collection is not obtained through the form of numbers or calculations in data collection. Gunawan's opinion, qualitative research tries to describe or explain something in the form of interaction of human behavior in a particular event based on the researcher's point of view.<sup>1</sup> In addition, Nugrahani, research using the qualitative method aim to find out in-depth about the portrait of the situation in an experienced context (*natural setting*) about what happened according to the conditions that occurred in the field.<sup>2</sup>

All data are collected to determine the clarity of the research problem to be presented in the study. This research is devoted to the implementation of blended learning in English learning during the Coronavirus pandemic. It explains the analysis of the implementation of blended learning by English teachers, obstacles, solutions to the obstacles, and the benefits in the implementation of blended learning in English learning at SMP NU Putri Nawa Kartika Kudus.

#### B. Research Setting

The research location is an area where research is possibly conducted. The researcher take SMP NU Putri Nawa Kartika Kudus which had implemented blended learning during the Coronavirus pandemic. The research timeline is from 4 July to 6 August 2022. During this research, because of the Coronavirus pandemic, learning was conducted online. However, with a new policy from the government, learning could be done both face-to-face and online.

### C. Research Subject

The subjects or participants in this research are English teachers and several 8<sup>th</sup>-grade students at SMP NU Putri Nawa Kartika Kudus as samples. In selecting participants, the researcher use a probably sampling or random sampling technique. Random sampling is taking the participants randomly in simple way or random numbers.<sup>3</sup> The researcher also adds data from their principal, the vice principal of curriculum, to ensure the validity of data obtained from English teachers and students. The researcher will collect data and documentation and then analyze the data.

### D. Instrument and Data Collection Technique

Instruments and techniques for collecting data used in this study are:

#### 1. Observation

Observation in this research is used to collect data by focusing on an object. Observation is one of the research methods used in appropriate research strategies to observe behavior in the environment that occurs naturally.<sup>4</sup>

The researcher conducted direct observations at SMP NU Putri Nawa Kartika Kudus which implemented blended learning during the Covid-19 pandemic. The researcher observe the application of blended learning both face-to-face and online. This observation is conducted on how the implementation of blended learning during the Covid-19 pandemic in English learning, benefits, supporting factors, obstacles experienced during implementation, and solutions to resolve the obstacles experienced at the eighth grade of SMP NU Putri Nawa Kartika Kudus.

#### 2. Interview

The interview is an effective technique for gathering important information about the personality and character of the people. The interview can be defined as a form of consultation in which the researcher wants to explore in-depth information based on the exposure of individuals who are asked by the researcher about a problem.<sup>5</sup>

In this study, the researcher used written notes and audio records. The object will be studied is an English teacher in grade 8, several students in the 8<sup>th</sup> grade, the principal and the vice principal of curriculum at SMP NU Putri Nawa Kartika Kudus who applied blended learning during the Covid-19 pandemic includes the implementation and obstacles faced in the English learning process.

### 3. Documentation

The documentation in this study is conducted to collect data in the form of images during the face-to-face learning process and screenshots of learning using the WhatsApp application in online learning during the implementation of blended learning in learning English.

### E. Research Data Validity

Validity in qualitative research is the suitability of the desired results from the tools, processes, data, and methodologies to answer research questions so that the design use is valid for sampling and data analysis so that the final results and conclusions are correct.<sup>6</sup> The validity of the data used by the researcher here is triangulation. Triangulation is used for the process of examining data in qualitative research, evaluating various sources of evidence to corroborate and validate the information.<sup>7</sup> The following are the types of triangulation used by the researcher:

#### 1. Source Triangulation

Source triangulation is used to collect data and check the credibility of data from various available sources.<sup>8</sup> Therefore, the researcher collected data from the English teacher of SMP NU Putri Nawa Kartika Kudus, students, the principal, and the vice principal of curriculum.

#### 2. Technique Triangulation

The triangulation technique is used to collect data and check the credibility of the data with different techniques from the same

source.<sup>9</sup> In this study, the researcher examines the results of the study using observation, interview, and documentation data collection techniques so that the validity of the data can be trusted.

## F. Data Analysis Technique

Data analysis is an effort to find and organize data based on the results of observations, interviews, and others to increase understanding of the problems in research and then present them to others as findings.<sup>10</sup> So, data analysis is the process of collecting data from various sources systematically. The stages of data analysis used by the researcher are:

### 1. Data Collection

Data collection is data in the field in the form of words and actions of individuals who are observed or interviewed as the main data source, while additional data sources come from written sources such as books, scientific journals, and so on.<sup>11</sup> In this study, the data collected is conducted by observing and interviewing the participants. The data are in the form of written notes and audio records. After data collection is done, the researcher can do the next stage of data analysis.

### 2. Data Reduction

Data reduction is the process of summarizing, selecting, and focusing on simplifying data that emerges from notes in the field.<sup>12</sup> In this study, the researcher summarizes, selects the things that are needed, and finds important points from the results of data collection to reduce things that are not needed to present clear information and the researcher makes it easier to collect the next data needed.

### 3. Data Display

The display of data is the activity of collecting structured information so it is possible to draw conclusions and take action.<sup>13</sup> In this research, the data presented is conducted to make the
